



Enrollment Priority

Acceptance into a PACCC program from the waitlist will be based upon the schedule needed compared to the space available, and on the following priorities:

- 1) Child or sibling currently enrolled in a PACCC program
- 2) For Fall 2021: Child enrolled in 2021 PACCC Summer Camp
- 3) Child on the Regular Waitlist, in the following order
 - a. Resident of Palo Alto, ordered by waitlist date
 - b. After School Kids' Clubs only: Child attends the PAUSD School where the Kids' Club is located
 - c. Non-Palo Alto Residents, ordered by waitlist date

Non-ambulatory children will always receive priority for the licensed non-ambulatory slots.

Child Protective Services referred families will always receive priority.

Families on the Family Partnership Program (financial aid) eligibility list will always receive priority for the designated subsidized child care spots at each center, when funds are available.

Special consideration may be given, based on needed mix of age groups, families undergoing crisis, full-time working parent(s), or other extenuating circumstance, with approval of PACCC's Executive Director.
