Funding Criteria

- Parent/Guardian must be a resident of California, or
- Parent/Guardian must be eligible to work in the State of California
- In addition, parent/guardian must:
 - fit within the California State Department of Education Income Guidelines
 - be employed, or
 - seeking employment (for infant-toddler and preschool programs only), or
 - be a student in an accredited program, or be unable to care for the child due to disability (incapacitated)

Income Guidelines

For Santa Clara County Pilot Child Care and Development Programs (85% SMI)

- Family size includes parents/guardians and the children for whom the parents are responsible, who comprises the household in which the child receiving services is living.
- Monthly gross income may not exceed the amounts shown to be eligible for subsidized child care or preschool services.
- Ceilings based on 2018 American Community Survey (ACS) information provided by California Department of Finance 2020. Ceilings may revise yearly to reflect most current ACS information.
