



Dear PACCC Parent/Guardian,

The Healthy Schools Act of 2000 (as amended by Assembly Bill 2865, Chapter 865, Statutes of 2006) requires that all schools and child day care centers provide parents or guardians of children who are enrolled at the facility with written notification of expected pesticide use at schools and day care centers.

Parents/Guardians may request prior notification of individual pesticide applications at the child care center. If requested, parents/guardians will be notified at least 24 hours before each pesticide application.

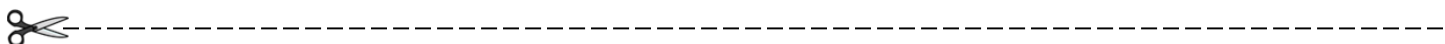
