


August is National Immunization Month



As a reminder, The California Department of Public Health (CDPH) recommends that students get routine vaccines prior to the new school year to "help protect the health of children, teens, and communities." Please note that "California law requires students to receive age-specific immunizations in order to attend public and private elementary and secondary schools as well as licensed childcare centers. Schools and licensed childcare centers are required to enforce immunization requirements, maintain immunization records of all children enrolled, and report children's immunization status to CDPH. Families can visit CDPH's Shots for School and Don't Wait -Vaccinate! webpages for information on immunization laws and required vaccinations for students in California."
