Funding Criteria

- Parent/Guardian must be a resident of California, or
- Parent/Guardian must be eligible to work in the State of California, or
- In addition, parent/guardian must:
 - fit within the California State Department of Education Income Guidelines
 - be employed, or
 - seeking employment (for infant-toddler and preschool programs only), or
 - identified as Homeless, or referral from CPS
 - be a student in an accredited program, or
 - be unable to care for the child due to disability (incapacitated)

Income Guidelines

Income Ceilings for subsidized Child Care services provided through City of Palo Alto funding*

- Family size includes parents/guardians and all children living in the home.
- Monthly gross income may not exceed the amounts shown to be eligible for subsidized childcare services.

Schedule of Income Ceilings (85 percent SMI) for Santa Clara County Pilot Child Care and Development Programs*

Family Size	Family Monthly Maximum Gross Income to remain eligible
1–2	\$5,899
3	\$6,511
4	\$7,441
5	\$8,632
6	\$9,823
